## INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION

Z87 Accredited Standards Committee on Eye & Face Protection

Membership on the Z87 Committee is generally by an organization, such as a trade association, technical association, business, labor organization or similar entity that represents more than one individual. Individuals with particular expertise in the activities of the Committee may be also considered for membership. Membership on the Committee, or one of its subcommittees, is subject to review and approval by the Committee and the recommendation of the Secretariat, International Safety Equipment Association.

Provide additional sheets or continue answers on the back of the application, if needed, to fully answer all questions.

- 1. ANSI Essential Requirements specify that all entities with a direct and material interest in the scope of the Z87 Committee have a right to participate in the development of standard(s) under the authority of the Committee. This includes the right to express a position and the basis for that position, have it considered by the Committee, and appeal an adverse decision by the Committee. An organization or individual can so participate without being a member of the Committee. Specify the applicant's direct and material interest in the scope of the Committee.
- 2. ANSI *Essential Requirements* prohibit unreasonably restricting membership on the basis of technical qualifications, but expertise that can be of assistance to the Committee in developing standards is an important consideration. Providing a description of the expertise of the organization and the individual designated representatives will assist the Committee in approving membership and assigning a subcommittee position, if appropriate.
- 3. ANSI *Essential Requirements* require that accredited standards committees make an effort to attain a balance of interests. The attached categories apply to members of the Z87 Committee and its subcommittees. Select the category that best describes your relationship to the activities of the Committee.
- 4. The *Procedures of the* Z87 *ANSI Accredited Standards Committee* require members to actively participate in the Committee by attending meetings, responding to ballots and acknowledging the rules and responsibilities of the Committee. Organizational members actively participate by appointing representatives who they deem to be qualified and who actively participate, and by responding to inquiries to confirm representation. Failure to actively participate is grounds for removal from the Committee.
- 5. If the applicant is an organization, such as a trade association, business, labor organization or similar entity, please so indicate, otherwise indicate "individual". As deemed appropriate by the Committee, an applicant may be accepted for membership on the Z87 Committee, and/or one of its subcommittees. Specify all positions for which the applicant seeks membership.

- 6. If the applicant is an organization, the organization must specify an organizational contact responsible for designating, or confirming, the organization's primary and alternate representatives. The organizational contact may also serve as the primary or alternate representative. To maximize attendance at meetings, specifying an alternate who can participate in the absence of the primary representative is highly recommended. Individual applicants generally do not have an alternate. On approval of membership, the representatives will be asked to read the *Z87 Committee Procedures* and other materials, and acknowledge their acceptance of the rules of the Committee.
- 7. If the applicant is an organization, the application should be signed by the organizational contact, or other individual authorized to represent the organization.

## **Z87 Committee Interest Categories and Definitions**

<u>Manufacturer</u>: An organization that produces the product or represents producers of the product, or components thereof, covered by the Committee.

<u>User:</u> An organization (company, association, government agency, individual) that uses and/or purchases the product covered by the Committee.

<u>Government</u>: A government agency or department that has an interest in the use of products covered by the Committee. (Agencies or departments that use such products should select the User category).

<u>Technical/professional</u>: An entity (individual expert, professional society, test lab, etc.) that has specialized knowledge and expertise in the products, components or testing covered the Committee.

<u>General Interest</u>: An organization or individual that has a special interest in this standard due to safety, technical or other requirements with demonstrated knowledge in the area(s) covered by the Committee and does not fit under another category.
